# Nominations

B.C.'s aggregate industry plays an important role in building an affordable and prosperous British Columbia. However, aggregate producers play a much larger part in our communities than purely providing the necessary resources for the construction of homes, public infrastructure, and roads.

Their contribution takes a variety of forms including volunteering labour and equipment for community projects and events and supporting local organizations.

The Deputy Minister's Community Service Award recognizes the outstanding contribution the aggregate industry provides to communities across the province.

The award will be presented at the BC Stone, Sand and Gravel Association Annual General Meeting in May 2020.

## Nomination Packages

Nomination packages must include:

- A completed application form
- A letter of nomination (two-page maximum) describing the contribution made by the company and the benefit to the community
- Supporting information such as citations, media releases, media coverage, photographs, support and thank you letters

## Eligibility

Companies in the aggregates industry that have supplied at least one project in a BC community during the year are eligible for this award.

Nominations can be submitted by anyone who would like to recognize the contribution of an aggregate producer to a community.

Nominations can be submitted by:

- Community members
- Members of the aggregate industry

## Selection Criteria

The nominations will be evaluated on qualitative assessments of two criteria:

- The benefits to the community
- The contribution made by nominees
