Application Packages

Application packages must be submitted by May 15, 2026 Applications must include:

- Acompleted application form
- A letter (two-page maximum) describing the contribution made by the company and the benefit to the community
- Supporting information such as citations, media releases, media coverage, links, photographs, supportand thank you letters

Eligibility

Companies in the aggregates industry that have supplied at least one project in a BC community duringtheyearareeligibleforthisaward.

Applications can be submitted by aggregate producers ,oranyone who would like to recognize the contribution of an aggregate producer to a community.

Selection Criteria

The applications will be evaluated on qualitative assessments of two criteria:

- · The benefits to the community
- · The contribution made by producer
